

NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 01, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 572 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT THEY INTERSECTED THE NORTH BOUNDARY OF THE TOWNSHIP [4TH STANDARD PARALLEL SOUTH] AT 26.87 CHAINS WEST OF THE CORNER TO SECTION 35 & 36 AND 53.26 CHAINS EAST OF THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 34 & 35 IN TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST. THE QUARTER CORNER WAS NOT ESTABLISHED ON THE PARALLEL. THEY SAID THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 12" X 3"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 1 & 2-21-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 46.38 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 19" X 10" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 1 & 2-21-12
 - 2) 86.38 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 24" X 14" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 1, 2, 11 & 12-21-12
- 2) J. H. PARKMAN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1907 TO 1915, IN SURVEY NUMBER 189, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 1 ON PAGE 9 REQUESTED BY R. A. McILVAIN TO MAKE A SURVEY OF 5 ACRES ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-20-12, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 1-21-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL. HE USED THIS STONE AND THE INTERSECTION OF THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 35-20-12 TO SET A STONE FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 35-20-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THE SURVEY WAS BEGUN ON APRIL 5, 1907.
- 3) W. D. KRETSINGER, L.S. 363, COUNTY ENGINEER FROM 1952 TO 1981, IN SURVEY F01001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 21-12 FOR THE SURVEY FOR A 8.78 TRACT IN THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 1-21-12 DATED SEPTEMBER 22, 1972, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING AN **IRON PIN** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 1-21-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL. THIS SECTION CORNER IS ALSO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE 8.78 ACRE TRACT. **VERIFY AND CHECK FOR THE STONE OF RECORD AS THERE IS NO INDICATION OF THE METHODOLOGY HE USED TO DETERMINE THE IRON PIN WAS THE SECTION CORNER ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
- HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 452' SOUTH TO THE IRON PIN HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE 8.78 ACRE TRACT
 - 2) 847' EAST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE IRON PIN HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE 8.78 ACRE TRACT
