

CENTER 1/4 CORNER SECTION 04, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 50 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 198 DATED MAY 16 & JUNE 6, 1872 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF SECTION 4-21-12 AND SUBDIVIDE THE NORTH 1/2 OF SECTION 4, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER OF SECTION 4-21-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 2,640' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12
 - 2) 1,320' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 4-21-12
 - 3) 2,151' NORTH TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND
 - 4) 2,976' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL
 - 5) 1,320' EAST TO THE STONE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 4-21-12
 - 6) 2,640' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 4-21-12

- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F04001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 21-12 FOR A SURVEY FOR THE LYON COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT DATED APRIL 27, 1983, SAID THAT HE SEARCHED FOR THE STONE AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12, BUT HE DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE. HE SAID THAT THE POSITION OF AN OLD CORNER FENCE POST IS REASONABLE. **HE CALCULATED COORDINATES** FOR THE POSITION OF THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12, BUT HE DID **NOT MONUMENT** THE POSITION FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12 ON THIS SURVEY.
