

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 04 TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) NOTES FOR AN 80 FOOT WIDE STATE ROAD FROM 110 MILE CREEK IN OSAGE COUNTY TO ELMENDARO IN LYON COUNTY FILED AND RECORDED BY THE LYON COUNTY CLERK ON SEPTEMBER 3, 1866 AND RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGES 64 TO 66 [PACKET 152 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE], STATES THAT THEY ENDED THE ROAD SURVEY AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-21-12 – THE CORNER OF ELMENDARO TOWNSITE. THE SURVEY WAS PERFORMED BY H. D. PRESTON, SURVEYOR.

- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 50 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 198 DATED MAY 16 & JUNE 6, 1872 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF SECTION 4-21-12 AND SUBDIVIDE THE NORTH 1/2 OF SECTION 4, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL ON LINE BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,884' EAST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE TEMPORARY SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-20-12
 - 2) 2,639-1/2' EAST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12
 - 3) 759' WEST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 32 & 33-21-12
 - 4) 1,600-1/2' WEST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE 40 ACRE LOT
 - 5) 2,643-1/2' WEST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12
 - 6) 825' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND
 - 7) 1,656' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/21/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 4-21-12
 - 8) 2,976' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12
 - 9) 5,616' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12

- 3) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F04001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 21-12 FOR A SURVEY FOR THE LYON COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT DATED APRIL 27, 1983, SAID THAT THE POSITION FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL FALLS IN A CREEK. **HE CALCULATED COORDINATES** FOR THE POSITION OF THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL, BUT HE DID **NOT MONUMENT** THE POSITION FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12 ON THIS SURVEY.
