

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 05, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 73 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 130 DATED JUNE 14, 1875 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 INTO NORTH & SOUTH HALVES IN SECTION 5-21-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-21-12 ON LINE BETWEEN THE POST THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-21-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 5-21-12 AND AT 1,320' NORTH OF THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 5-21-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,646' NORTH TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-21-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL
- 2) 1,320' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 5-21-12
- 3) 2,640' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 5-21-12
- 4) 3,960' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-21-12
