

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 05, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 73 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 130 DATED JUNE 14, 1875 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 INTO NORTH & SOUTH HALVES IN SECTION 5-21-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-21-12 ON LINE BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 5-21-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-21-12 AND AT 1,320' NORTH OF THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-21-12 THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION

- 1) 1,617' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 5-21-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL
- 2) 1,320' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-21-12
- 3) 2,643-1/2' SOUTH TO THE 15" X 4" X 5" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 5-21-12
- 4) 3,967' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 5-21-12
