

**CENTER 1/4 CORNER SECTION 06, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 123, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 123 DATED SEPTEMBER 21-28, 1885 ORDERED BY SAMUEL BURDETTE TO SURVEY SECTION 6-21-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A 3" X 8" X 12" SANDSTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-12 ON LINE BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-12 ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL AND STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-12 AND 2,640' NORTH OF THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE NOTED THAT "THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY WAS SHORT 16 FEET TO THE MILE" ALONG THE RANGE LINE.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 1,320' SOUTH TO THE 4" X 4" X 36" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 6-21-12
- 2) 2,640' SOUTH TO THE 4" X 12" X 18" SANDSTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-12
- 3) 1,320' NORTH TO THE LIMESTONE HE SET IN A HEDGE FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 6-21-12
- 4) 2,954' NORTH TO THE 5" X 5" X 24" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORER OF SECTION 6-21-12 ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL
- 5) 1,320' WEST TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 6-21-12
- 6) 1,320' EAST TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 6-21-12
- 7) 2,640' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 6-21-12
