

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 06, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 123, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 123 DATED SEPTEMBER 21-28, 1885 ORDERED BY SAMUEL BURDETTE TO SURVEY SECTION 6-21-12, SAID THAT HE SET A **3" X 5" X 19" LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-21-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE NOTED THAT "THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY WAS SHORT 16 FEET TO THE MILE" ALONG THE RANGE LINE.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 448' WEST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-12 ON THE RANGE LINE
- 2) 1,320' EAST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE 5" X 5" X 24" LIMESTONE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-12
- 3) 2,640' EAST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO A STAKE HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 6-21-12
- 4) 3,960' EAST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-12
