

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 06, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 123, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 123 DATED SEPTEMBER 21-28, 1885 ORDERED BY SAMUEL BURDETTE TO SURVEY SECTION 6-21-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A 4" X 14" X 36" LIMESTONE MARKED "1/V111" ON THE WEST SIDE AND A "+" ON THE TOP AND 2 FEET EAST OF TRUE LINE** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-21-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE NOTED THAT "THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY WAS SHORT 16 FEET TO THE MILE" ALONG THE RANGE LINE.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,320' SOUTH TO THE 4" X 12" X 18" SANDSTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-12
- 2) 1,320' NORTH TO THE 3" X 8" X 12" SANDSTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-12
- 3) 2,640' NORTH TO THE LIMESTONE HE SET IN A HEDGE FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 6-21-12
- 4) 4,274' NORTH TO THE 5" X 5" X 24" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL
