

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 09, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 584 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 13" X 4"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 4 & 9-21-12.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 39.94 CHAINS WEST TO THE 28" X 17" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 4, 5, 8 & 9-21-12
 - 2) 39.94 CHAINS EAST TO THE 21" X 12" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 3, 4, 9 & 10-21-12

- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 50 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 198 DATED MAY 16 & JUNE 6, 1872 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF SECTION 4-21-12 AND SUBDIVIDE THE NORTH 1/2 OF SAID SECTION 4, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTIONS 4-19-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

 - 1) 2,640' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12
 - 2) 3,960' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 4-21-12
 - 3) 4,791' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND
 - 4) 5,616' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL
