BREINER TO SURVEY THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-21-12 AND THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 11-21-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 11-21-12 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES/ DRAWING SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 159 RODS, 23.6 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11-21-12
  - 2) 158 RODS, 12-1/2 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11-21-12
