

**CENTER 1/4 CORNER SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 67 OF THE 7<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 215 DATED OCTOBER 2, 1872 TO FIND THE CORNERS OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 12-21-12, STATES THAT **HE SET A WALNUT POST** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,323' NORTH TO THE WALNUT POST HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 12-21-12
  - 2) 2,646' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12
  - 3) 2,646' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12
  - 4) 2,665' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12 ON THE RANGE LINE
- 2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 35, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 216 DATED NOVEMBER 18, 1901 ORDERED BY G. W. GASCHÉ TO LOCATE AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 12-21-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A 4" X 14" X 18" SANDSTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN HIS BOOK 3 ON PAGE 14 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS, AND THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 51" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 2 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.

- 1) 1,325-1/2' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE S1/2 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12-21-12
- 2) 2,651' NORTH TO THE FLAG HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12
- 3) 2,651' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12
