

**WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 570 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 26" X 10" X 4"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 11 & 12-21-12.
  
- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 67 OF THE 7<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 215 DATED OCTOBER 2, 1872 TO FIND THE CORNERS OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 12-21-12, STATES THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION
  - 1) 1,326' NORTH TO THE LOCATION FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 12 – [**NOTE:** HE DID NOT SAY IF HE RETURNED TO SET A MONUMENT AT THIS 1/2/4 CORNER – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR]
  - 2) 2,652' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12
  
- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, BY FRANK P. MACLEMAN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 206 DATED MAY 2, 1878 ORDERED BY H. BREINER TO SURVEY THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-21-12 AND THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 11-21-12, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11-21-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
  
- 4) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 35, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 216 DATED NOVEMBER 18, 1901 ORDERED BY G. W. GASCHÉ TO LOCATE AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 12-21-12, SAID THAT HE DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. **HE SET A FLAG AS A TEMPORARY CORNER** ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12 AND THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE TEMPORARY SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN HIS BOOK 3 ON PAGE 14 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS, AND THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 51" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 2 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION
  - 1) 1,316' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 12-21-12
  - 2) 2,646' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12
  - 3) 2,646' SOUTH TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE TEMPORARY SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12
  - 4) 5,271' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND LOOSE ON THE GROUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13-21-12 – HE DID **NOT** USE THIS STONE ON THIS SURVEY
  - 5) 7,938-1/2' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 13-21-12
