- 1) ON PAGE 579 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 17" X 11" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 10 & 15-21-12.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.17-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO THE 21" X 13" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 10, 11, 14 & 15-21-12
 - 2) 40.17-1/2 CHAINS EAST TO THE 33" X 10" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 10, 11, 14 & 15-21-12

- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, BY FRANK P. MACLEMAN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 206 DATED MAY 2, 1878 ORDERED BY H. BREINER TO SURVEY THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-21-12 AND THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 11-21-12, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 10-21-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
