

**SOUTHWEST CORNER SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 101 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 14" X 13" X 6"** FOR THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 21 & 22 SOUTH, RANGES 11 & 12 EAST ON NOVEMBER 13, 1856, FROM WHICH:
  - 1) A COTTONWOOD TREE 28" IN DIA. BEARS N. 60° E. AT 100 LINKS DISTANCE
  - 2) A WALNUT TREE 14" IN DIAMETER BEARS S. 45° E. AT 127 LINKS DISTANCE

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

  - 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 14" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-21-12
  - 2) 80.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 16" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-21-12
  - 3) 31.86 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE 14" X 11" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 31-21-12
  - 4) 71.86 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE 30" X 14" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 31 & 32-21-12
  
- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 170, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 170 DATED JUNE 2 & 3, 1887 ORDERED BY C. H. HOLTON TO LOCATE THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11 AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER ON THE LYON AND GREENWOOD COUNTY LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

  - 1) 2,629' WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11
  - 2) 5,258' WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11
