

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 103 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 14" X 12" X 3"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-21-12 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY ON NOVEMBER 14, 1856.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 16" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-21-12
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 14" X 13" X 6" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 21 & 22 SOUTH, RANGES 11 & 12 EAST AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-21-12 ON THE COUNTY LINE
- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 170, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 170 DATED JUNE 2 & 3, 1887 ORDERED BY C. H. HOLTON TO LOCATE THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11 ON THE RANGE LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
