

**NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 576 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 24" X 11" X 3"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 27, 28, 33 & 34-21-12.  
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 39.85 CHAINS EAST TO THE 20" X 15" X 2-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 27 & 34-21-12
  - 2) 79.70 CHAINS EAST TO THE 28" X 14" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 26, 27, 34 & 35-21-12
  
- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 47 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 190 TO 192 PETITION BY D. C. CALLEN AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIPS 21-12 AND 21-13 [PACKET 133 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON SEPTEMBER 17, 1879, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT ROAD, **EXCEPT** WHERE HEDGE FENCES ARE STANDING AND GROWING, ON OCTOBER 6, 1879, AND WAS RECORDED ON OCTOBER 6, 1879 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 34-21-12 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-21-12 ON THE RANGE LINE AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
  - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 34-21-13 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY ON THE LYON AND COFFEY COUNTY LINE
  
- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 130 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 106 TO 108 PETITIONED BY J. P. ROSS AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 21-12 THAT HE SURVEYED ON SEPTEMBER 30, 1881, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD TO THE SECTION LINE AND THEN 50 FOOT WIDE FROM THE SECTION LINE SOUTH ON OCTOBER 5, 1881 AS NOTED BY J. M. GRIFFITH, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON OCTOBER 14, 1881 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28-21-12 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) THIS 50' WIDE ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 4-21-12; THEN CONTINUES WEST ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD FOR 800 FEET; THEN EXTENDS NORTHERLY TO THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 33-20-12 ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
  - 2) THEN CONTINUES SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINES AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-21-12 ON THE LYON AND GREENWOOD COUNTY LINE AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
  
- 4) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON THE RIGHT PAGE 225 DATED SEPTEMBER 30, 1881, FOR A ROAD SURVEY IN TOWNSHIP 21-12 SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28-21-12 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY  
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) THIS 50' WIDE ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 4-21-12; THEN CONTINUES WEST ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD FOR 800 FEET; THEN EXTENDS

NORTHERLY TO THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 33-20-12 ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 2) THEN CONTINUES SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINES AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-21-12 ON THE LYON AND GREENWOOD COUNTY LINE AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
  
- 5) COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B", PAGE 133  
ON AUGUST 15, 1962 A PETITION SIGNED BY GEORGE NUESSEN AND OTHERS FOR THE VACATION OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 22-12 WAS PRESENTED TO W. A. STOLFUS, COUNTY CLERK. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND W. D. KRETSINGER, COUNTY ENGINEER, ON SEPTEMBER 5, 1962 AND THE FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON SEPTEMBER 5, 1962 VACATED THE FOLLOWING ROAD:
  - 1) BEGINNING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-21-12 AND TERMINATING AT ONE-HALF (1/2) MILE SOUTH.
