- 2) COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B", PAGE 133
ON AUGUST 15, 1962 A PETITION SIGNED BY GEORGE NUESSEN AND OTHERS FOR THE **VACATION** OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 22-12 WAS PRESENTED TO W. A. STOLFUS, COUNTY CLERK. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND W. D. KRETSINGER, COUNTY ENGINEER, ON SEPTEMBER 5, 1962 AND THE FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON SEPTEMBER 5, 1962 **VACATED** THE FOLLOWING ROAD:
 - 1) BEGINNING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-21-12 AND TERMINATING AT ONE-HALF (1/2) MILE SOUTH.

ON FEBRUARY 24, 1977 A PETITION SIGNED BY ED HUBER AND OTHERS FOR THE **VACATION** OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 21-12 WAS PRESENTED TO ROSEMARY SPALDING, COUNTY CLERK. THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS VIEWED THE ROAD ON MARCH 18, 1977 AND RECOMMENDED THAT THE FOLLOWING ROAD BE **VACATED AS PETITIONED:**
 - 1) THE ROAD 1/2 MILE SOUTH BETWEEN SECTIONS 33 & 34-21-12.
