DAY FOR ANNA DAY, HIS WIFE, TO SURVEY THEIR TRACT IN SECTION 36-21-12, SAID THAT **HE DROVE A HEDGE STAKE** FOR THE 1/8TH CORNER IN THE CENTER OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THE SURVEY WAS MADE ON JUNE 10 & 11, 1907 AND WAS ENTERED ON SEPTEMBER 14, 1907.

HIS NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,320' WEST TO THE HEDGE STAKE HE DROVE FOR THE WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 35-21-12, AT 9" NORTH OF A LINE OF FENCE RUNNING EAST AND 1 FOOT WEST OF A LINE OF FENCE RUNNING SOUTH
