

**EAST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 03, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) CHARLES A. DOW, COFFEY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 154 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 202 TO 204 FOR PETITION BY THOMAS HUGHES AND OTHERS FOR A ROAD ON THE LYON AND COFFEY COUNTY LINE IN TOWNSHIP 21-13 [PACKET 446 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON NOVEMBER 22, 1881, AND WAS ESTABLISHED AT VARYING WIDTHS ON APRIL 21, 1882 BY H. F. HOLMES, CHAIRMAN OF THE LYON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 2-21-13 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY ON THE LYON AND COFFEY COUNTY LINE.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE COUNTY LINE AS AN 80 FOOT WIDE ROAD FOR 1/4 MILE TO THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 2-21-13; THEN CONTINUES SOUTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 2, 3, 10 & 11-21-13 AS A 60 FOOT WIDE ROAD; THEN JOGS 5 FEET EAST AND CONTINUES SOUTH AT 5 FEET PARALLEL TO THE COUNTY LINE AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD TO A POINT 5 FEET EAST OF THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14-21-13; THEN JOGS 5 FEET WEST TO THE COUNTY LINE AND CONTINUES SOUTH ON THE COUNTY LINE AS A 60 FOOT WIDE ROAD TO THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 34 & 35 ON THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF TOWNSHIP 21-13 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY ON THE LYON, COFFEY AND GREENWOOD COUNTY LINE
- 2) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 6 FOR A ROAD SURVEY IN TOWNSHIP 19-13 DATED MAY 26, 1882, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER BETWEEN THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE EAST AND THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 3-21-13 ON THE LYON AND COFFEY COUNTY LINE TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 7.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO AN ANGLE STONE HE SET ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 3) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 175 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGES 286 TO 288 PETITIONED BY JAMES McCARTY AND OTHERS FOR A CHANGE IN THE ROAD LOCATION IN SECTION 3-21-13 [PACKET 416 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON MAY 26, 1882, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JULY 22, 1882 AS NOTED BY HUGH F. HOLMES, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON JULY 22, 1882 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT HE BEGAN THIS ROAD SURVEY AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 3-21-13 ON THE LYON AND COFFEY COUNTY LINE. HE DID NOT SAY IF HE FOUND OR SET A STONE FOR THIS CORNER.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE COUNTY LINE FOR 7 CHAINS [LAYING THE ROAD ALL ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE SECTION LINE] TO A STONE HE SET ON THIS ROAD SURVEY; THEN EXTENDS N. 42°30' W. FOR 5.70 CHAINS TO THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 3-21-13 TO INTERSECT THE ROAD FORMERLY LAID OUT AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
