

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 03, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

1) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 128 DATED APRIL 26, 1882 TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 3-21-12, SAID THAT HE SET A STONE FOR THE NORTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 3-21-13 ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 3-21-13 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-21-13 ON THIS SURVEY.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 20.15 CHAINS WEST ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 3-21-13
- 2) 20.15 CHAINS EAST ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-21-13
- 3) 60.45 CHAINS EAST ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 3-21-13 ON THE LYON AND COFFEY COUNTY LINE
- 4) 28.39 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER IN THE CENTER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 3-21-13
- 5) 48.39 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 3-21-13
