

NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 688 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 23" X 13" X 4"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 9, 10, 15 & 16-1-13.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.18 CHAINS EAST TO THE 23" X 10" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 10 & 15-21-13
 - 2) 80.36 CHAINS EAST TO THE 30" X 15" X 2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 10, 11, 14 & 15-21-13 ON THE COUNTY LINE

- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGE 219 [PACKET 279 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] PETITIONED BY DANIEL RICH AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIPS 20-13 AND 21-13 THAT HE SURVEYED ON AUGUST 14 & 15, 1874, THAT WAS FILED ON FEBRUARY 5, 1875 AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD EXCEPT AT THE CROSSING OF EAGLE CREEK IN SECTION 33-20-13 WHERE IT IS TO BE 60 FEET WIDE FOR 10 RODS ON EACH SIDE OF THE CENTER OF THE CHANNEL OF THE CREEK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE AT THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 10, 15, 16 & 21-21-13 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY**
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 3-21-13 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL AT A TURN TO THE WEST
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINE FOR 38.66 RODS SOUTH OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 15-21-13 AT A TURN TO THE SOUTHWESTERLY DUE TO A CREEK

- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 116 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 50 TO 52 PETITIONED BY DAVID SMITH AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 21-13 [PACKET 367 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON JUNE 9, 1881, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JULY 8, 1881 AS NOTED BY J. M. GRIFFITH, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON JULY 12, 1881 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 16-21-13 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.**
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 16-21-13 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS ROAD CONTINUES EAST, TAKING 14 FEET OFF THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SECTION LINE AND 26 FEET OFF THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SECTION LINE, EXCEPT WHERE IT RUNS THROUGH THE TIMBER AND WHERE THERE IS NO HEDGE, THE ROAD SHALL BE EQUALLY ON BOTH SIDES OF THE SECTION LINE, TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 15-21-13 ON THE LYON AND COFFEY COUNTY LINE AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
