

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 99 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 10" X 4"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-21-13 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY ON JUNE 2, 1856.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 22" X 9" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER OF SECTIONS 30 & 31-21-13
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 24" X 12" X 2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 21 & 22 SOUTH, RANGES 12 & 13 EAST AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-21-13
- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 61, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 61 DATED SEPTEMBER 5, 1884 AT THE REQUEST OF J. W. ELLIS FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 21, RANGES 12 & 13, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-12 ON THE RANGE LINE ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 12-21-12 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND THE LYON AND GREENWOOD COUNTY LINE TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 3) SEE THE ROAD SURVEY FOR THE VARYING WIDTHS
